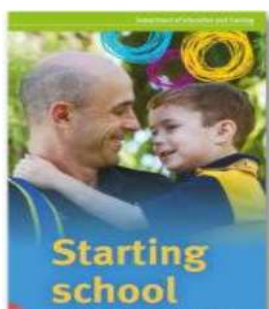
### **Lest We Forget: ANZAC Day Parade**
