Trees: As previously discussed with the P&C, the three trees between E and G blocks have been assessed due to their current safety concerns as a result of disease and root damage to pavements and drainage. An independent arborist assessment has recommended that these be removed and this work will occur in the near future.

Once the trees have been removed and paving and drainage has been repaired, we will work with our P&C to install suitable shade structures for our students and community.


