### Regional Showcase Achievement:



Last Friday Mrs Burton (Head of Curriculum) and I attended the Regional Showcase Awards Breakfast for our entry: Collaborating to Empower through Mathematics. In our Early Years and Primary category there were four entries from across our region.

Congratulations to our entire school for their efforts in enabling this entry to be submitted and for the significant results that have been achieved over the last 18 months. Our entry achieved an outstanding **Regional Commendation** and subsequently \$500 prize money.

The winning entry from Hatton Vale received the Regional Showcase Award and \$1000. This result reflected 5 years of work in the Regional improvement area of Reading. The other two entries were also in the Regional improvement area of Reading and their data was gathered over 3 or 4 years of efforts.

We were the only entry with a mathematics agenda and to be recognised for our efforts and results over a relatively short timeframe compared to the others is a significant reflection of the work that has been completed by Mrs Burton, our PLC Maths Leaders and our teaching staff. Well done everyone involved and thank you to Mrs Burton for all of her leadership of this component of our school strategic anchor and the efforts that she put into the submission. ### Parent Notification of Upcoming Teacher Industrial Action: Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2019

The below notification is provided to ensure families are aware and well prepared for the following industrial action that will occur on Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> July.

*Dear parents/carers,*

*Queensland Teachers' Union members have voted to stop work for 24 hours on Thursday, 18 July.*

*As the vast majority of state school teachers and principals are members of the QTU and the secret ballot was passed overwhelmingly, that means that every state school in Queensland will be effectively closed on that day.*

*This is teachers' first state-wide stop-work in 10 years. The QTU's 46,000 members voted to take the action because the Queensland Government has not made an offer in the current enterprise bargaining negotiations, even though the existing EB expires on 30 June and negotiations have been ongoing since February.*

*"Learning Achieving and Growing Every Day."*

Negotiations between the QTU and the government are continuing, and the Union remains hopeful that a fair offer from the government can avert the stop-work action. However, in the event that an offer isn't made, please be prepared to make alternative arrangements for your children on Thursday, 18 July.

Thank you and have a wonderfully safe and restful holiday everyone – it's been a massive Semester One and everyone (students, staff and community) have achieved significant individual and collective results. Reflecting on our PBL presentation and the P&C of the year entry, we have an amazing school and sometimes we need to sit back and enjoy the spoils of the huge efforts and achievements we all make to our amazing school – that's The Rangeville Way.

### Electricity Conservation Program

We have been fortunate to be selected as one of 30 trial schools for an upcoming electricity conservation program. Over the upcoming holiday period, an audit of our school will be conducted and, following this, a plan developed. We will then have potentially \$100,000 worth of lights replaced with power-saving alternatives and solar panels installed with the aim of reducing the school's reliance on the power grid. Participation in this program will complement the sustainability initiatives already underway.
