Student Late Slips new process trial for the rest of the year

From this coming Monday, our students who arrive late will be asked to collect their late slips from the new Student Services window situated on the outside of the Administration Building between C Block and D Block. This change comes about from the need to reduce the number of students and adults accessing the office area between 8:45am and 9:15am. As it is a requirement that all late students are signed into School by an adult, we ask that you assist with this trial and wait along the cement pathway leading to the student services window. Mrs Giles will issue your child with a late slip from this point during this time. At all other times, please see the administration staff in the office. Thank you for your assistance with this trial change to our morning routine.


