Priority School Review Finalisation

During the last week of Term Two, our school underwent the final phase of our Priority School Review. The 12-month review looked at how the school implemented the improvement strategies from the action plan:

- Collaboratively develop, implement and monitor strategies to enhance the professional culture of the school, improve staff members' morale and promote wellbeing.
- Use the model for planning curriculum units in English in other learning areas, to enable consistency of curriculum planning and alignment to the Australian Curriculum

Free dental care is offered to all Queensland students from the age of four to the completion of Grade 10 through the School Dental Service. The dental team consists of a dentist, dental therapists, oral health therapists and dental assistants. You will be advised if your child needs specialist dental treatment.

Students at **Rangeville State School – Years 4 – 5 - 6** are now being offered dental treatment. If you would like your child/children to participate in the free dental care program, please complete each section of the registration form, sign and return it to the School Office by **Friday 17th August 2018**.

Please note that by signing this form, you are only advising our service of your wish to participate in the dental care program and providing personal information to allow us to contact you. Using the information that you provide to us, a staff member will contact you to arrange an appointment.

- Students will be seen at the Dental Clinic (South St) located on the grounds of **Rangeville State School**
- Parents/Legal Guardians **must** attend all appointments
- There are limited appointments available before and after school and most appointments will have to be during school time
- Oral Health does not accept any responsibility for transport of the children to and from their appointments
