NAPLAN Results are in – WOW for our U2B'S!!!

Congratulations to all staff, students and families – everyone has contributed to this year's fabulous NAPLAN results.

The NAPLAN data has been received and we have achieved significant improvements across the board in all areas especially reading and writing. In all areas we have achieved either equal to the nation or above the nation achievements. Highlights include:



- Year 3 and 5 students achieved **above the nation** in Reading and Grammar and Punctuation.
- **57%** of our Year 3 and Year 5 students achieved results recorded in the Upper Two Bands for Reading. One Year 3 class has over 70% of its students in the U2B's for reading.
- **56%** of Year 3 students achieved results recorded in the Upper Two Bands for Writing.
- **55%** of Year 3 students achieved results recorded in the Upper Two Bands for Spelling.
- **61%** of Year 3 students and **52%** of Year 5 students achieved results recorded in the Upper Two Bands for Grammar and Punctuation.

This data is something to be **SHOUTING ABOUT** and each student, family member and staff member from Prep – Year 6 can be very proud of their contributions to the overall student results. Well done everyone.

Congratulations to all students who participated in this Year's Instrumental Eisteddfod. All staff have reported that our students were exemplary examples of Learning, Achieving and Growing Every Day.
