### Daily Attendance

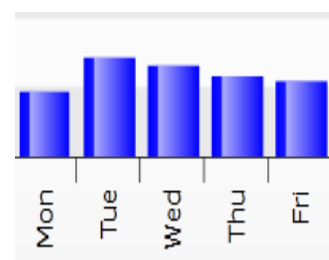
#### Attendance Rate
