EARLY CUT OFF TIME FOR OVER THE COUNTER PAYMENTS

Thank you to everyone for abiding by the new timelines for over the counter payments. Everyone has been accepting of this new process and it has had a huge impact on the workflow for the ladies in the office. Don't forget the other payment options are over the phone credit card, cheques and BPoint. Each week more and more people are using BPoint to pay their account. When making a BPoint payment you will need the CRN, Invoice number, Student Name and Amount. It is important all of this information goes into the first screen to ensure the payment goes through immediately.

CUT OFF TIME FOR REFUNDS

Please be aware there is now an **TWO business day turn-around** after the event to request a refund. If the event involves a bus you may need to supply a doctors' certificate as the quotes for those events are worked out on a certain number of children attending the event and often many months in advance.
