### As the Temperatures Drop our Learning Heats Up!!!

This is an exciting time of the term in which all of our classes are fully engaged in showcasing and celebrating what has been learnt. Students and teachers are busy completing assessment pieces that will be used for final judgements that contribute to the students' report cards that will be sent home for all on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> June. Please keep in contact with your child's teacher if your child is absent in the coming weeks.

### Student Absences

We often get phone calls from parents asking our advice about when to keep children home from school. We follow the Queensland Government 'Time Out' information chart which we find invaluable

([https://www.health.qld.gov.au/ph/documents/cdb/timeout\\_poster.pdf](https://www.health.qld.gov.au/ph/documents/cdb/timeout_poster.pdf)) The most common ailments that cause concern are:

#### Conjunctivitis:

Exclude until discharge from eyes has ceased unless non-infectious conjunctivitis.

#### Diarrhoea and/or Vomiting:

Exclude until there has not been a loose bowel motion for 24 hours. Exclude staff whose work involves food handling until they have not had any diarrhoea or vomiting for 48 hours.

#### Head Lice:

Exclusion is not necessary if effective treatment is commenced prior to the next attendance day (i.e. the child does not need to be sent home immediately if head lice are detected)

#### School Sores/Impetigo:

Exclude case until has received appropriate antibiotics for at least 24 hours. Sores are not contagious if covered, or after the child has taken antibiotics for 24 hours. Weeping or crusted sores on exposed areas should always be covered with a watertight dressing until at least 24 hours post antibiotics commenced and for as long as practical.

### Staff Professional Development

Last Tuesday our entire staff began a 3 part series of Professional Development delivered by Dr Peter Stebbins focused on workforce wellbeing, leadership and team transformation. Our first session focused on workplace personality styles and the session was facilitated through a series of fun and interactive exercises to develop a whole of team profile and understanding the strengths and areas of potential clashes amongst our team and some practical strategies to leverage individual differences to maximise our team performance. ## School Banking Account Opening Day



The School Banking program provides children with an opportunity to deposit money into their Commonwealth Bank Youthsaver account at school each week. The program is about how often your child makes deposits, not how much they deposit.

To encourage regular savings behaviour the program offers an exciting Rewards Program. Every deposit earns your child a Dollarmites token, and once they've collected 10 tokens they can redeem them for a reward.

School Banking is also a great fundraiser for our school. Our school receives \$5 when a student makes their first ever School Banking deposit and 5% on every deposit made through the school (to a maximum of \$10 per individual deposit).

Alternatively, you can open an account at your local branch. All you need to bring is your current identification as well as your child's birth certificate. If you are an existing Commonwealth Bank customer and have NetBank, you can open an account online.

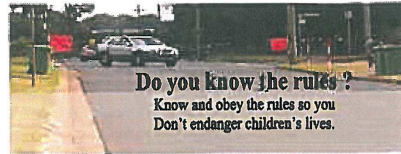

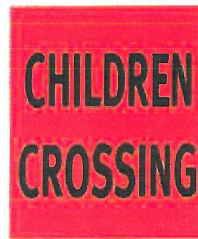
### School Zones



The school zone sign shows:

- maximum permissible speed
- time periods in which the speed limit applies.

### Children's Crossing



A driver's guide for children's crossings:

- Travel slow enough so you are able to stop if required.
- Stop if a pedestrian is on or waiting to enter the crossing.
- Do not proceed until all pedestrians have reached the footpath or centre median.
- Crossings divided by a centre median are separate crossings.
- Do not stop within 20 metres of crossing approach and 10 metres on crossing departure or as signed.
