Day 1 Procedures for Monday 23rd January 2017

To help things flow more smoothly on Monday 23rd January we will be conducting the same procedures as this year and the details are as follows:

- ✓ In 2017, the name of your child's teacher and their room location will be provided at the same time you receive the end of year Student Report Card – Wednesday 7th December.
- ✓ This should help to reduce Day 1 anxiety for some children.
- ✓ Please note, Class Teachers and Administration have spent many hours determining class lists and taking into account the feedback provided by parents. However, depending on enrolments, some class

adjustments may need to be made. Therefore, when preparing your child's books and other resources over the holidays please do not label them with the class name.

- ✓ Changes may occur and this is the downside of advising families of likely class allocations before the end of the school year.
- ✓ Additional parking will be available on the top oval (access via South St) and a Parking Marshall will be on duty. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN STAFF CARPARKS.**
- ✓ There will be no Class Lists posted in the School Halls for 2017. Parents and students will simply arrive anytime on from 8.15am and locate their classrooms. Classrooms will not be accessible before 8.15am.
- ✓ Class Lists will be posted on classroom doors for Day 1 only. Due to Privacy Legislation I respectfully advise that photos of these lists for Facebook Posts etc. are not permitted.
