

Mathematics :

1. **Signpost Maths Books** : Work we have completed (Some students may have been absent so this work is included) and other REVIEW activities students should complete without a calculator include: Pages :- 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 38, 39, 48, 73, 90.

PLEASE DO NOT WORK AHEAD AND COMPLETE OTHER PAGES EXCEPT THE ONES OUTLINED. TEACHERS WILL NEED TO INSTRUCT THE STUDENTS IN ANY NEW WORK.

2. **Mathletics PROGRAM.** The class teachers will set activities for students to complete each week. Once this work is completed students may work on **Mathletics LIVE**, or go into any other area on the program and complete the tasks. Use the helper who is the “Cool Guy” on the left to teach you how to complete the set task. ALL STUDENTS WILL NEED PAPER OR A WHITEBOARD TO DO WORKING OUT. The Year 6 work is not only mental maths activities – operations and computation are required.
3. **Number fact review.**
 - “Hit The Button” game on google. This game will allow students to focus on multiplication or division. Choose the different tables that you are slow to recall. Ultimately you can do mixed facts which includes all table groups.
 - Mathletics live. Choose levels 4 and above only! You can do the number fact activities in the program also.
 - Number fact cards. Cut an A4 piece of card into 12 (or more) smaller cards. Use a different colour for each number fact family. Write the multiplication fact or division fact on the front of the card and the answer on the back. Make sure you have the correct answer! Shuffle the cards and quickly answer the fact. Keep a pile of slow to answer / wrong answer cards to write out and repeat over and over. Do not mix up the times/division tables until you know each family separately.
 - Teachers have a copy book of activities when all other work is completed.

ENGLISH : AR will be on-line at home :

1. **READING** : Students should **read for a minimum of 1 hour every day**. They can choose from:
AR books at their level/ home books / Magazines / Newspapers / On-line research activities about Australian History – Political System – Passing a BILL in Parliament or Science Research on a topic of interest.
The students need to **record this reading in their school diary every day**. Write the TITLE or the read item, the pages that they read and the time that they read for.
2. **Writing.** Students should keep a journal of writing in their draft writing book. This could be :
 - Writing 5 dictionary meanings and 5 complex sentences with spelling words each day - drawn from the weekly spelling list.

- Research notes on the topic that you may have researched in your reading activity from above. ie A newspaper article retell / History research / Science research notes. This work needs to be written in complete sentences with correct punctuation. Write in pencil, using cursive script.
 - Write a short story. Edit your work and then publish it in neat cursive script or type it up on the computer. You have seen the assessment sheet for this term so check that you are writing at the same level as the assessment task sheet.
3. **School spelling program.** Take home your – Word Warm- Up Booklet. We do 8 lists per Term (One list only per week) Term 1 was List 1 – 8. Term 2 will be Lists 9 – 16. Get your carer to pre-test the **ONE list for the week.** Complete the HOMEWORK ACTIVITIES on that LIST, as usual. You can also complete the Spelling Activity Book from class on that list. Do not go ahead in this book as you need to have a deep understanding of each group of words. Do 5 dictionary meanings of words from the list and then use those words in your 5 complex, interesting sentences.

HASS:

1. We have some **copied History sheets** about the Australian Political System and how our government works. You may need to do some research on your electronic device to complete these sheets.
2. Research : Research one of **Australia’s past** (or Present) **Prime Ministers.** Using the TEEL paragraph structure, edit your research notes and compose a paragraph about your person.
3. Research : **Citizenship in Australia.** A. Who is a citizen in our country?
B. How do you become a citizen in Australia if you are not already?
C. What are your rights as a citizen? D. What are your responsibilities?
4. **Watch BTN** (Behind the News) and write a paragraph about the topics viewed.

Science : You tube : **Bill Nye –The Science Guy.** Choose a topic of interest. Write the title as the heading in your Science book – Write at least 1 paragraph about what you learnt in the program.
