Rangeville State School Two Week Student Supervision Arrangements: January 24 – February 4, 2022 – Information for Parents

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Thank you for your ongoing support as we work together to respond to the evolving COVID-19 situation. Our school will remain open for children of essential workers and vulnerable children during this period and they will be provided with appropriate supervision only. If you need to send your child to school you must ensure your child is well and not displaying any signs of illness. We will contact you to collect your child if they demonstrate any signs and symptoms of illness.

As we are reducing the number of staff on our school site to minimise transmission and further protect the health and safety of our school community, we will not be providing teaching activities during this time. As part of our duty of care, we will ensure that roll marking processes and follow up communication continues; that individual health needs are supported and individual behaviour support and wellbeing check-ins are prioritised. It is important to note that even though we are operating under slightly different circumstances our school's three PBL behaviour expectations, **Be Safe, Be Respectful and Be a Learner** will be enacted.

On Monday 24 January, 2022, all class teachers, if they are able to be on site, will be in their own classrooms with their own roll class from **8:50 am – 1:00pm**. We intend to use this time to focus on informal 'Welcome Back' and social engagement activities so that all students can 'touch base' with their 2022 class teacher before amalgamated class arrangements begin. This will occur even if numbers are only small in each class and will allow for an audit of whole school numbers so appropriate supervision arrangements can be organised for the following eight days.

Please see the points below for logistical arrangements:

- **School Hours/Routine:**
 - Normal School hours will operate during this two-week supervision period.
 - Supervision **does not** begin before 8:30am – ROHSC is available from 6:30am.
 - Morning Session starts at 8:45 am
 - Morning Tea 10:50 am
 - Lunchtime 1:00 pm
 - Afternoon session finishes at 2:55 pm
- **Students are to bring:**
 - Stationery (pencil case/ colours/scissors/glue etc)
 - Mini whiteboard & whiteboard markers
 - Reading books/ board games/card games (**no electronic devices!**)
 - Backpack with morning tea, lunch & water bottle – Tuckshop **will not** be operating in Week 1
 - 1 X scrapbook/notebook
 - A ream of A4 photocopy paper



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- Folder for storing any drawings, activities etc
- Students are to wear sports uniform, closed in shoes & broad brimmed hat.

• **Drop Off and Collection:**

While parents and carers are welcome on school sites, all adults must adhere to the Chief Health Officer's directions and restrictions, e.g. face masks and social distancing. In order, to prioritise the health and wellbeing of our workforce and community and also minimise the potential of overcrowding/congestion on the school grounds, we are asking parents to follow the procedures that were enacted in 2020 for collection and drop off of students.

These procedures include:

- the requirement that adults (staff and parents) should maintain a physical distance of 1.5 metres from each other to help prevent the transmission of COVID-19
- staff and parents to observe physical distancing measures by not congregating in areas inside or around the school including at drop off and pick up time
- supervision at school gates, including during drop off and pick up times and supervised movements between the school gate and classrooms.

To enable the above to occur we will be introducing the following arrangements for the entire school until further notice depending on further COVID-19 advice.

Quick Drop Off and Pick Up Zones:

Whilst trying to mitigate potential traffic flow issues and enable effective movement to and from our classrooms for our students we will be implementing the following Drop Off and Pick Up Zones. Teachers or school staff will **meet students** in the morning and **return them** to these designated places each day.

Prep and their siblings: Petal Street Drop Off and Pick Up Zone:

Prep students and their siblings to access the school site via the pedestrian gate near the Petal Street entrance. Signs will be placed in the Prep Playground area for each class.

Year One and their siblings - High Street Drop Off and Pick Up Zone:

Year One and their siblings enter school site via High Street via **the pedestrian gate in front of their classrooms in J Block.**

Year Two and Three - High Street Drop Off and Pick Up Zone:

Years Two and Three will enter the school site via the **High Street Blue gates.**

Year Four - High Street Drop Off and Pick Up Zone:

Year Four will enter the school site via the double gates (near Resource Centre) on **High Street.**



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Year Five and Six - High Street Drop Off and Pick Up Zone:

Years Five and Six will enter the school site via the Music Gate on **High Street**

ROSCH will continue their current practices for drop off and pick up for our Prep and Year One students.
